

## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORKSHOP POTENTIAL MEASURES UNDER CONSIDERATION FOR THE 2017 PM2.5 PLAN**

The District has been undergoing a robust public process to develop an attainment strategy to address multiple PM2.5 standards including holding a number of public meetings, public workshops, and Public Advisory Workgroup meetings. Through this process, the District has identified potential control measures for a number of source categories, including a number of potential local measures to reduce directly emitted PM2.5 and NOx emissions, and potential measures to reduce emissions from mobile sources.

The District will hold a public workshop to seek input and feedback from the public on the following for each potential measure:

1. Are the measures identified by the District effective in reducing air pollution?
2. Are the measures identified by the District technologically feasible?
3. Are the measures identified by the District economically feasible?
4. Are there any other feasible measures that the District should consider?

The public workshop will be held at **2:00 PM on Monday, May 8, 2017**. The workshop may be attended in person at the District's Fresno office located at 1990 E.
