

NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORKSHOP 2017 PM2.5 ATTAINMENT STRATEGY

The San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District invites you to attend a public workshop co-hosted with the California Air Resources Board to present, discuss, and receive feedback on the *2017 PM2.5 Attainment Strategy* at **5:30 PM on Tuesday, September 26, 2017**.

This workshop is the latest in the District's robust public process to develop an attainment strategy to address multiple PM2.5 standards including holding a number of public meetings, public workshops, and Public Advisory Workgroup meetings. Through this process, the District has identified potential control measures for a number of source categories, including a number of potential local measures to reduce directly emitted PM2.5 and NOx emissions, and potential measures to reduce emissions from mobile sources.

The workshop will provide an update on continued efforts in refining the proposed attainment strategy and lay out the remaining steps for development of the comprehensive strategy. This will include a review of potential District and ARB regulatory and incentive-based control measures and an update on the latest air quality modeling activities.

The public workshop will be held at **5:30 PM on Tuesday, September 26, 2017** and may be attended in person at the District's Bakersfield office located at 34946 Flyover Court, Bakersfield, CA 93308, via video teleconference at the District's Fresno office (1990 E.
