California Air Resources Board to simulcast statewide meeting on air pollution control measures in Fresno

Interested parties invited to attend and testify

The California Air Resources Board will hold a technical workshop to discuss proposed state and federal air pollution control measures to be included in new State Implementation Plans (SIPs) due later this year. The forum is open to all interested parties and will be held from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on April 22, 2003. In addition to locations in Sacramento and El Monte, residents in the San Joaquin Valley can attend via video-teleconference at the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District, 1990 East Gettysburg Ave. in Fresno.
